# 2021-22 President's Report



Congratulations to all Hillgrove players on their contribution to the 2021-2022 season. How gratefull we are to have completed the season with minimal interruptions. It was great to see the teams being able to take to the pitch each weekend, despite a few rain delays. All senior teams made it into the finals, with both 2nd and 3rd grade taking out the premierships. 1st grade fell just shy of the final playing city in the preliminary final. The 1st Grade team made 121, but City managed to chase it down with 4 wickets to spare, finishing off first grades season. 2nd grade finished competition rounds in 4th position, with good wins over TAS and Guyra in the semi's, they made the grand final and took out the win over City, bowling them out for 75 and getting the runs with 6 wickets to spare. 3rd grade finished in second position, with a minor hiccup in the semi-final with East, but came back solidly in the preliminary final to beat Guyra by 6 wickets and had sweet revenge against East to beat them by 24 runs in the Grand Final. All players should be congratulated on their efforts for the season.

A big thank you to the captains for each side, Brad King, David Waters, Tony Butler as well as the chairman of selectors Jerome Simpson for the tireless efforts to ensure we had 11 on the pitch each and every weekend. # **Hillgrove Colts C.C. Perpetual Trophies**

**Peter Hickey Memorial Trophy** 



The Peter Hickey Memorial Trophy for the player **most likely to succeed**, is in memory of the late Peter Hickey who played 1<sup>st</sup> grade for the club for approximately 10 years during the late 1970's to the late 1980's. He was an exceptionally talented bowler, and had been on a world tour with the Northern NSW Emu's Cricket club in 1974. The trophy was donated by his family after his untimely death in 1991.



#### The Royal Hotel Trophy - Clubman of the year



The royal hotel trophy for clubman of the year would've been donated by Joe Barbato the owner and publican of the Royal hotel. They were our club sponsors for approximately 10yrs in the late 80's early 90's. Joe himself never actually played cricket for Hillgrove, however his son Peter played in the lower grades for the grove.

# 2021-22 Second Grade



Another season has come to an end and it's a pleasure to report second grade have managed their second Grand Final win in a row... But wow, we did it the hard way.

Last season, if you can remember we were minor and major premiers and were undefeated throughout the season.

This season between games lost, two washouts and a bye it was December 18 before our first win which was in the T20 competition held from December 11 to January 26.

From there we gained some momentum winning 4 from 4 T20 games and ended up joint premiers with Guyra after that final was unfortunately washed out in the 10th over - we were 1-60 and in a very strong position.

Highlights from the T20 competition were Darcy McElroy finding his mojo leading the wicket tally with 8 wickets at an average of 6.63 and Tim Chapman batting into some form scoring 149 from five innings at an average of 37.25 with scores of 39, 37, 40 and 33 not out. This is on top of a 50 in round two - turns out he had a lucky charm watching from the sideline.

Returning to the 45 over competition on the bottom of the ladder we had some work to do in the back end of the season. With the in form Chapman selected in 1sts, 'the science department' Cam Lay, Dave Moffitt and Jono Schumack stepped up with the bat and did the hard yards when needed.

We missed out on third position on the ladder by the narrowest of margins but nevertheless made it to the finals.

Winning the toss and electing to bat in the Semi Final v TAS we scored 6–248 off our 45 overs which included a massive 131 from Dave Schmude who batted 41 overs, and 27 and 41 from Moffitt and Waters respectively.

With Cuz asked to play 1sts to replace the injured Harris in came Stew Maxwell, with the new ball in hand didn't he deliver, taking 2–23 off his opening 8. Sheeraz chimed in with 3–13 but honors went to PK Sinha bowling 7 overs taking 4 for 4, bowling five maidens, three of them wicket maidens. We won that game by 171 runs!

The following week in the Semi Final against Guyra, we won the toss and batted on a difficult wicket. Before the game I thought 100 would be enough on the acerage at Bellevue, we just had to bowl & field well. Although the science department dug in, Moffat 13, Lay 18 and Schumack 11, we were all out for 96..

In the field Maxwell again applied relentless pressure taking 2-27 off 7 and Sheeraz capitalised at the other end with 6–16, that's an opening bowling partnership of 8–37!!!

Tails between their legs Guyra were rolled for 52, remaining wickets to PK 1–11 off 5 and Brock Parsons 1-2 off 2 and we were off to the grand final v City.

Having to get to the GF the hard way only benefited us, the egoless self belief and comradery the side developed leading up to this game was pretty special to witness and whether batting, bowling or fielding we remained patient and stuck to the plan. I couldn't be more proud of the boys

The grand final was no different. Losing the toss and having to bowl we set about making runs difficult to score. We took everything catchable and saved plenty. Cuz 'the maiden master' bowled 6 overs in his opening spell, bowling five maidens, 1 a wicket maiden, for only one run. Sheeraz bowled 9 straight at the other end and took 3-21. Brock, hungry to bowl more than his allowed six overs, took 2-20 & the ever reliable Moffitt 7 overs 1-15. After being 6-42 at drinks (23 overs) City were bowled out in the 34th over for 75 with a running catch in the deep to Scotty Clarke. Other fielding highlights were 2 catches to Casey Rainger behind the stumps and a pivotal catch to Cuz on the boundary to remove the dangerous Ash Clee for 4.

The science department again did the heavy lifting with the bat, Lay 13, Moffitt 16, Chapman 19 and Schumack 8no until Simo swatted a flighted ball from Simon Butler down the ground to win the game, 4-78 in the 26th over. Soo the Grove!

At times this year it felt like we had exhausted all known players for team selections and what has to nearly be a record, 2nds played 32 different players in 14 games.

Congratulations to 1sts on making the Preliminary Final this year & to 3rds on your very courageous Grand Final win over Easts, a great achievement TB & team.




